MERMC 2023 - Teams

Competition Format of MERMC 2023

- 2 tracks of MERMC 2023 :
 - Trading with FMCG (v11)
 - 20 teams 40 teams (depending on registration)
 - Retail + B2B + HRM
 - Full Enterprise (v10)
 - 20 teams 40 teams (depending on registration)
 - All modules on, with crisis and roadmap
- Each team can only pick 1 track
- 3 first-round games (all teams) + 2 second-round games (10 teams each track) + 1 Presentation (10 teams each track)

Competition Format of MERMC 2023

- 3 first-round games (summing up) to qualify to second round
 - Total score aggregated from 3 games
 - 10 teams selected for each of the 2 tracks.
- Second round (10 teams per track)
 - 2 games + 1 presentation
- Score computation (to ensure fairness & performance consistency):
 - Score for each of the 5 games:
 - 75% scoring matrix + 25% ranking (ranking allocation from 100% with 10% descending to minimum 30%)
- Total score to produce the champion and runners-up (every game counts!)
 - 35% (1st-round games) + 45% (2nd round games) + 20% (presentation)

Competition Format of MERMC 2023

- Each game will be 1 hour, 10 teams per session
- Only 2 concurrent sessions (for 2 tracks) per hour
- Teams will wait for the turn of the assigned session.
- Schedule (for 2 tracks)
 - Round 1 Game 1 : Thu Afternoon (all teams)
 - Round 1 Game 2 : Fri Morning (all teams)
 - Round 1 Game 3 : Fri Afternoon (all teams)
 - Sum of scores of 3 games to qualify to Round 2
 - Round 2 Game 1 : Sat Morning (10 teams each track)
 - Round 2 Game 2 : Sat Morning (10 teams each track)
 - Presentation : Sat afternoon (2nd round, 10 teams each track)

Total score to produce the champion and runners-up (every game counts!)

• 35% (1st-round games) + 45% (2nd round games) + 20% (presentation)






